Footnotes

JANIES SONG prompted the pace on the outside, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, edged clear in upper stretch and held well under right hand urging. COOKIE DOUGH was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the far turn, moved off the rail at the top of the stretch, came between rivals in the vicinity of the furlong marker and finished willingly for the place. SWEET VICTORY ROSE bumped lightly with a rival after the start, raced inside on the first turn, moved out while off the pace on the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. WAGER N WIN bumped lightly with a rival at the start, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and finished with good late energy. WATERTOWN ROAD settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and also lacked the needed kick. MISS KATY LAKE settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, steadied while blocked passing the furlong marker, lacked room behind rivals late and lost any chance. DU GOOD BABY settled on the outside, was roused on the far turn and lacked the needed response. ISLAND ARTIST bumped lightly with a rival after the start, was taken in hand while off

heels early, raced inside on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn, steadied while blocked at the top of the stretch, continued blocked to the furlong marker, moved out and lacked the needed response. ZAMITA saved ground on the first turn, lingered near the back of the field, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and also lacked the needed response. SCHARLYN bumped lightly with a rival at the start, set the pace on the inside through moderate fractions, lost the lead outside the quarter-pole, was in a tad tight while dropping back leaving the far turn and gave way. SHARE THE DREAM raced three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, raced off the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. IRISH SOUL raced well back in the field, moved up some while urged along on the backstretch, went four then five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 20 Feet)
