ECONOMIC RECOVERY was taken in hand early then rated just off the pace on the inside, drafted behind the leader on the far turn, waited passing the three-sixteenths pole, slipped through along the rail shortly thereafter, rallied into the final furlong, gained the lead inside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. SEND THE HEAT raced inside on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, bided his time while behind rivals on the far turn, came off the rail late on that bend, shifted three wide into the stretch, moved further to the outside and finished with good courage to get the place. LOOKIN HECTIC went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, advanced four wide on the far turn, took the lead passing the quarter-pole, edged clear in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while drifting out a bit late then lost the place. BUSY DREAMIN raced just off the pace, was asked while three wide on the far turn, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. HAMMERED STEEL settled towards the rear, went three then four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and improved position. BOREALIS STAR settled off the pace, went three then four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. AGREATFATHER broke about three to four lengths slow, went three wide on the first turn, lingered near the back, moved closer late on the backstretch, was caught in traffic early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole then dropped to three wide and failed to threaten. SLAMMING G set the pace on the inside, lost the lead passing the quarter-pole and gave way. DAVID L. settled towards the rear, raced off the rail on both turns and was no factor. FOUR FLAGS broke about two to three lengths slow, saved ground on the first turn, lagged near the back,

went three then four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and never reached contention. HENRY THE ACE broke out at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. GOODER stalked the pace on the outside, chased off the rail on the far turn and capitulated.
