SIDING chased the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled with PLAYATRICK and prevailed under strong urging. MACHO MAMA was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and closed well but was too late. PLAYATRICK chased on the outside, advanced leaving the backstretch, dueled three then two wide on the turn, battled with the winner in the stretch and was outfinished while clear for the show. B G MISS MEIMY was away alertly from the inside post, set the pace, dueled inside on the turn and tired. TRU IRON lacked early speed, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. LEA'S CROWN broke outward at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced four to five wide on the turn and was no factor. CUVEE TRENTO was sent hard from the start then ridden along in the middle of the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. LULA MAC was urged along towards the rear, raced off the rail on the turn and also failed to respond.
