EPIC MATCH dueled on the outside, drew off while off the rail on the turn and maintained a clear advantage under strong urging. DRUNK DIAL settled between rivals, raced off the rail early on the turn, swerved three wide near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back in near the quarter-pole and secured the place while no match for the winner. PRIMAL EXPLOSION was ridden along at the rear, raced three wide early on the turn, swerved five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to four wide near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response while clear for the show. TIN TOP was urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. HALIFAX FLYER was off slow, saved ground towards the rear and failed to respond. JOHN LOUIS CLASSIC dueled on the inside, dropped out abruptly while lugging out on the turn and stopped.
