Footnotes

PERFECT MEADOW was urged along on the outside, raced five then four wide on the turn, rallied outside in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under strong handling. BARMAID PRETTY chased the pace on the inside, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch, inched clear into the final furlong, lost the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while well clear for the place. SUPREME CATIE set the pace under pressure, dueled inside of PRAY MEETING on the turn, battled into the final furlong and tired while just able to get the show. PRAY MEETING came away alertly, pressed the pace on the outside, dueled three then two wide on the turn, vied into the final furlong and weakened then just missed the show. ALL I WANT was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. SANDIPAT was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and came up empty. PHANTOM OPERA was ridden along on the inside, moved off rail leaving the backstretch and failed to threaten. K D QUEEN was urged along in the middle of the field, raced three to four wide on the turn, drifted five wide near the quarter-pole and faded. WITT'S ATTITUDE was off two to three lengths slow, raced at the rear of the field and was no factor. WITT'S DYNAMITE lacked early speed, raced three wide on the turn, dropped to the inside near the quarter-pole and showed little.
