COUNTDOWN'S SEVEN was well placed just off the pace on the inside, chased on the far turn, was in tight outside the quarter-pole, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, made a bid on the outside, battled with FREE SAILING in the final furlong and proved best under steady urging. FREE SAILING set the pace on the inside through quick fractions, inched clear near the quarter-pole, was challenged in upper stretch, battled with the winner in the final furlong and missed. DOUBLEUPTOCATCHUP bumped with a rival at the start, raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, lingered well back in the field, moved out while roused on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. FESTIVE DANCER came out and bumped with a rival at the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, advanced four then five wide on the far turn, was in striking range in upper stretch but flattened out. HOLY SAINT raced two then three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, saved ground on the far turn, was blocked badly passing the quarter-pole, swung out at the top of the stretch and improved position. JETHRO raced three wide on the first

turn, settled off the pace, moved up while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, held a good striking position but lacked the needed response. HERE COMES BADNESS settled well off the pace, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. MALABAR SLEW settled off the pace while off the rail, was roused on the far turn and came up empty. SPEED MONSTER was taken back in the early going, raced inside on the first turn, lagged near the back, went three to four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. HEZA TWELTH MAN prompted the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn and came up empty. RIVER RIDGE went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three then four wide on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 20 Feet)
