STAND WATIE stumbled badly at the start, settled off the pace, went three to four wide on the turn, rallied in upper stretch, gained the lead near the sixteenth-pole then edged clear under urging. ITSADONEDEALMISTER settled towards the rear, went four then five wide on the turn, rallied alongside the winner, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole but was outfinished while able to get the place. STROBE LIGHT raced well back in the field, went two then three wide on the turn, angled out near the three-sixteenths pole, came between rivals outside the furlong marker and got up for the show. BOSS M moved up on the inside to contest the pace, vied inside on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch but was overtaken. LEXINGTON PARK settled off the pace, was blocked from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter-pole, steadied along the rail near the three-sixteenths pole, moved to the outside and improved position. WIMBLEDON'S FIRE settled just off the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, was caught in traffic near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. JAGGED EDGE settled towards the rear, went five to six wide on the turn and failed to threaten. SMOKINLEX disputed the pace on the outside, vied into upper stretch then gave way. AMBER'S DEPUTY raced just off the pace, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. GEORGE A. pressed the pace on the outside, chased three then two wide on the turn, was in tight from the quarter-pole to the three-sixteenths pole and tired. OBADIAH stumbled at the start, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four then three wide on the turn and came up empty. SHINING VALUE was urged some while on the outside, went four to five wide on the turn and retreated.
