Footnotes

SPEED FEST settled just off the pace, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under right hand urging. STORMIN QUALITY was well placed on the inside, came under a ride on the far turn, swung out at the top of the stretch, closed well to make a bid near the sixteenth-pole and just missed. REBALITE set the pace while off the rail, inched clear passing the quarter-pole, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and weakened while able to hold the show. PERFECTYSEATTLE raced three wide on the first turn, pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and gave way. CRITICAL REASON settled well back in the field, raced four then five wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. LEMONY CRICKET moved in to save ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, lacked room behind traffic on the far turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and improved position. LIKE MY DAD settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and failed to rally. START A REVOLUTION dropped back at the start, lagged at the rear of the field, raced five then six wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. DUPLICATION stumbled badly at the start, settled between rivals, continued between rivals through the far turn and failed to respond. DO NOT DISTURB raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and also failed to respond.
