JOE MOVE showed good speed, dictated terms through the turn, responded well in the stretch and held sway under right hand urging. DISTINGUISH was urged along between rivals, raced off the rail on the turn and finished willingly for the place. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE was urged along on the outside, raced four then five wide on the turn, dropped in inside the quarter-pole and finished willingly to get the show. ORPHAN BRIGADE chased the pace on the outside, raced three then four wide on the turn and also finished willingly but missed the minor awards. FEARLESS ANTHONY chased the pace, lugged out on the turn and weakened. NEREUS was ridden along while off the pace, moved in to save ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. DARING CHILD lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. (Rail at 10 Feet)
