STAND WATIE went three wide on the first turn, settled well back in the field, went two then three wide on the far turn, was asked while shifting four wide inside the quarter-pole, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. T. C. CHAMP contested the pace under a very tight hold while along the rail, was asked at the top of the stretch, led determinedly into the final sixteenth but was caught. CABE disputed the pace between rivals while under a very strong hold, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get the show. GABRIEL'S MISSION was reserved on the inside, came under urging while continuing to save ground on the far turn, pursued the leader under a drive into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. UNDER OATH went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced three then two wide on the far turn and failed to rally. DA BOYSRBACKINTOWN lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch, raced off heels passing the furlong marker and failed to threaten. VEE ONE ROTATE stalked the pace while three wide and under a tight hold, was the first of the leading trio to be asked at the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired. TWO TURNS went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. JAKEONTHERUN raced off the rail on the first turn, was rated off the pace, came under urging leaving the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty.
