Footnotes

PONTOTOC settled on the inside, moved closer late on the backstretch, came off the rail near the quarter-pole, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed well to get the lead late and prevailed under good handling. F J UNCLE VIC raced off the rail on the first turn, moved closer early on the backstretch, settled towards the front, ranged up while two then three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, inched clear outside the furlong marker, drifted out inside that marker and was caught. GOT SHADES went four wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, moved off the rail while gaining into the stretch, chased into the final furlong, altered course towards the inside when the runner-up drifted out and finished willingly for the show. ALITTLEBITTOUCHY settled towards the back, was asked on the far turn and improved position. MAC WITT was fractious during the warm-up, went three then two wide on the first turn, contested the pace, vied into the stretch and gave way. SALTY SONG lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the turns and failed to threaten. BELL BOTTOM broke a tad in the air then drifted in at the start, contested the pace on the inside, vied into the stretch and tired. ANGLIANO lunged a bit at the start, settled towards the rear, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to rally. RARE LAD came out some after the start, lagged at the back, moved out in upper stretch, lugged out some near the furlong marker and showed little. SPECIAL MISFIT went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer late on the backstretch, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. FELINE FEVER lugged out to be five wide midway through the first turn, raced up close on the outside, chased three then four wide on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch and faded. LAZER CODE bore out badly on the first turn, drifted near the outside fence and was pulled up but walked off. Following a jockey's objection by the rider of GOT SHADES against the runner-up, no change was made to the order of finish.
