Footnotes

CHAMELEON raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, closed well to get the lead near the furlong marker then powered clear under strong urging. TI TOWNSHIP settled in the middle of the field, moved out on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. FAST ON FRIDAY bumped with a rival at the start, tracked the pace, took the lead with a half-mile to run, inched clear on the far turn, lost the lead near the furlong marker and weakened while able to hold the place. FAVORITE JAZZ settled while off the rail, lacked room near the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. GARTH was fractious in the gate, raced off the pace while urged along on

the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn and also failed to rally. MAD AT CHA saved ground on the first turn, lingered towards the rear of the field, raced off the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. EL MOJO bumped with a rival at the start, set the pace through quick fractions, relinquished the lead near the half-mile pole, dropped out on the far turn and gave way. ALLEGED HUG lagged well back in the field and never reached contention. TWO JAYS SECRET raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased the leader on the far turn and capitulated. OH OLEG raced four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace and failed to respond. GOLDON settled on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and dropped out. BURBON ROAD was always outrun. (Rail at 10 Feet)
