Footnotes

G G'S GIRL was well placed just off the pace, drafted behind rivals on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, moved to the outside, rallied in the final furlong and closed strongly to win going away. U GO ROY was forwardly placed on the outside, made a bid while three to four wide on the far turn, drifted out near the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the place. MOJO MANIA went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside while under some urging, moved closer with a half-mile to run, chased four to five wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, was taken up a bit inside the furlong marker and weakened while well clear for the show. BONNIE'S PROSPECT went three then two wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the far turn and tired. SEE THE STREAK settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. DREYFUS lagged at the rear while saving ground, shifted off the rail near the quarter-pole, came between rivals in upper stretch and failed to threaten. COOL'S PHIRE contested the pace, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. GO FOR DOUGH went three wide on the first turn, settled in fifth position, chased four wide on the far turn and capitulated. MINESTRIKE raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped in, settled towards the rear, moved closer with a half-mile to run, raced near the inside on the far turn and was no factor. RED CAJUN saved ground on the first turn, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and came up empty. DOITFORJOHNNY went four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn and failed to respond.
