WILD SLEW disputed the pace on the outside, battled with the runner-up in the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. RUNAHOLEINTHEWIND tracked the leading duo from third, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid near the eighth-pole, battled with the winner in the final furlong and missed. FATHER JESS settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, came out in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole, jostled with HEARTLAND FLYER at that point and finished willingly for the show. UNCLE GARDNER raced off the rail on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly to just miss the show. LORE'S DYNAMEAUX was well placed on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. CHANGING KARMA disputed the pace on the inside, vied into the final furlong and tired. HEARTLAND FLYER was reserved while off the rail, came

under urging on the far turn, raced under a drive into the final furlong, was jostled then taken up a bit near the sixteenth-pole and weakened. MISS MULLIGAN was reserved while three wide on the first turn, raced under some urging on the backstretch, went four wide on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. TATER RED went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along between rivals while off the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. SEVERE FLYING settled towards the rear, saved ground on the turns and was no factor. APRIL MAY FLY went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, raced three wide while urged along on the far turn and came up empty. CAT FROM ROME broke about three to four lengths behind the rest of the field, went four wide on both turns and trailed.
