Order of preference shall be determined as follows: First preference is to horses accumulating the highest total earnings, second preference is to winners at Lone Star Park, third preference is to horses accumulating the highest total earnings at Lone Star Park and fourth preference is to winners. CIRCUSTOWN FLYER pressed the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the turn, dueled gamely with the runner-up in the stretch and narrowly prevailed. TIME IZ FLYIN came in at the start, chased the pace on the outside, vied three to four wide on the turn, put a head in front in upper stretch, dueled gamely with the winner and just missed. CHECK RIDE came in early, set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired while able to get the show. YES IT'S A FACT was last away, raced near the back while urged along, went two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. OVERSPENT broke in at the start, was coaxed along near the inside, chased along the rail on the turn, was put to the whip near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. GOLDEN TUNE was ridden along on the outside, went three wide on the turn, dropped in at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten.
