(Two year olds of 2007, nominated as either weanlings or yearlings, by Accredited Texas Stallions of 2004 nominated with the Texas Thoroughbred Association to the Texas Stallion Stakes Series.) \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start with \$125,000 guaranteed to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Footnotes

GOLD COYOTE dueled on the inside, kicked clear at the top of the stretch and drew off under a strong drive. SPARK PLUG was hard ridden on the outside, raced three then four wide on the turn and earned the place while no match for the winner. STORMY DATE was ridden along in the second flight, saved ground on the turn, shifted out inside the furlong marker and tired while best of the rest. FIVE ALARM dueled on the outside, vied into the stretch and stopped. SILVERBACK CAT was void of speed, raced well back in the field and never reached contention. NAMESAKE raced between rivals in the second flight, continued between rivals through the turn and faded. K J'S BEAUX came out after the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and stopped. GROOMSMAN lacked speed while ridden along, came three wide into the stretch and showed little.
