FOR ACCREDITED TEXAS-BRED, THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start with \$50,000 guaranteed of which \$30,000 to the owner of the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth and \$1,500 to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 117 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; \$20,000 in 2012, 5 lbs.; \$15,000 since November 1, 2011, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2011-2012, as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company, will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, June 28, 2012 with 19 nominations. (S)

Footnotes

COYOTE LEGEND set the pace while off the rail, drew clear on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, responded well to the threat of SAFE RANGE and held gamely under good handling. SAFE RANGE brushed with a rival at the start, settled on the outside, was ridden along while four to five wide on the far turn, chased the winner into the final furlong, loomed a threat on the outside but was turned away while clearly second best. COOL HAND VAL went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, settled off the pace, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail entering the stretch and was best of the rest. SKIP A SMILE brushed with a rival at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled at the back, went two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole, drifted inward in upper stretch and failed to threaten. DADDY BEN settled towards the rear while on the inside, came off the rail outside the five-sixteenths pole and also failed to threaten. FLY THE RED EYE was well placed on the inside, saved ground on both turns and faded. COUGAR HOLLOW raced three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
