Footnotes

SARA KATHERINE was caught four wide entering the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, settled just off the pace, advanced with a half mile to run, made a three wide bid midway through the second turn, took the lead inside the quarter-pole, dueled with SIT ON SITONYA in the stretch, and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. SIT ON SITONYA contested the pace while three wide on the first turn, dropped behind the leaders near the five-furlong marker, saved ground on the second turn, came off the rail near the quarter-pole, shifted four wide to make a bid entering the stretch, dueled gamely with SARA KATHERINE in the drive, and just missed. VICTORY WOMAN was bumped at the start, raced five wide into the first turn, continued three wide on that turn, settled near the middle of the field, advanced leaving the backstretch, was hard ridden while three wide on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch, and finished willingly while unable to match the top two. STILL MINE raced five wide entering the first turn, continued four wide on that turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied into upper stretch, and weakened. TWILIGHT DEVIL settled near the inside, was ridden along on the far turn, and failed to rally. M G ON TAP was reluctant to load then broke a step slow, raced three or four wide on the first turn, lagged near the back of the field, and failed to threaten while passing tired rivals. EVRSTRIVE EVRSHINE contested the pace on the inside, vied into the stretch, and faded. JOLIE LOUISE raced four or five wide on both turns, and failed to reach contention. HOIST MY COLORS was caught six wide into the first turn, continued four wide on that turn, raced up close on the outside, vied four wide on the far turn, drifted five wide into the stretch, and stopped. WHAT ABOUT SUE broke outward and

bumped a rival, raced three or four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, and showed little. DR T'S MIRACLE was through after a half-mile, and eased then walked off. IDLE JOAN was through early and eased then walked off.
