Footnotes

ALMOST CERTAIN raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, rallied entering the final furlong and closed well to get up late. ERNESTO was rated off the pace while a bit rank, waited while between rivals on the far turn, rallied in upper stretch, drifted in passing the chute and missed. EDITOR'S CAT lunged at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, lugged out a bit on the far turn, gained the lead near the quarter-pole, inched clear in upper stretch, drifted in passing the chute and was overtaken. SIR RABBIT was reserved off the early pace, tried to move through on the rail inside the five-eighths pole but lacked room, settled at the rear, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed kick. GOLDON set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. JOESFULLOFIT was rated off the pace while a bit rank, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty. (Rail at 10 Feet)
