BLUE GRITS broke a bit awkwardly, set the pace while off the rail, extended the lead in upper stretch and held sway under strong right hand urging. WOULD YOU broke a bit slow, was ridden along towards the back, saved ground on the turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and closed well but was too late. TAP KLASS chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and finished willingly to get the show. BEHOLD DE BUY dropped back abruptly and moved out near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced four wide on the turn and finished willingly. BEAU MISSILE was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, drifted in late and also finished willingly. EURO SIERRA chased the pace on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and tired. YADACAT was in tight early then hard ridden on the inside, moved off the rail on the turn and came up empty. MAGESTIC WILDCAT bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and weakened. CHEROKEE ALPHABET bumped with a rival at the start, raced two to three wide on the turn and was no factor. COL. WRIGHT broke a bit slow, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond. JOHN LOUISMINISTER was off slow, raced near the rail on the turn and never reached contention.
