SHARP WAGER was well placed just behind the leader, chased while off the rail on the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong and held well under strong urging. JAZZ PARTY was ridden along on the inside, shifted three wide just inside the quarter-pole, swung four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. ROMP IN HOME lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, moved around a rival nearing the sixteenth-pole and reached his best stride too late while just up for the show. ANDRETTI was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response then just missed the show. BOSTON FEROCIOUS pressed the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and tired. TRIPLEMENTAL showed good natural speed and set the pace, moved clear in the vicinity of the half-mile pole, controlled the action while inside on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and weakened. NOBIZLIKEHORSEBIZ was ridden along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. SEBASTION chased the pace on the outside, came up empty while three wide on the turn and stopped.
