**Footnotes**

SUNSET RIDER bumped with a rival at the start, was unhurried at the back of the field, moved closer on the final turn, came three wide into the stretch, moved out once straightened for the drive, rallied in the center of the course, closed fast under confident hand urging, gained the lead inside the sixteenth-pole then moved clear while ridden out. B G ROYAL WEST was hard held early, went two then three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went three then four wide on the second turn, moved up on the outside with five furlongs to run, chased four wide on the final turn, battled through a long drive and finished willingly to get the place. RED ROCK CREEK was reserved off the pace while near the inside, moved closer on the final turn, waited while blocked from the quarter-pole to the furlong marker, checked passing that marker, moved to the outside then came between rivals and finished fast but lost any chance at the victory in a rough trip. TWILIGHT BAY raced on the inside while under a snug hold, was in tight off heels entering the second turn, remained in hand while just behind the leader, was blocked from the quarter-pole to the furlong marker, moved to the outside and finished willingly but just missed the minor awards in a tough trip. CHANDAS contested the pace on the inside, inched clear in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken. HEAVY AS METAL went three then two wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, lacked room from the quarter-pole into upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and also finished willingly. WAJIR ON ME settled on the inside, came off the rail midway through the second turn, moved out inside the five-eighths pole, was urged along while three then four wide on the final turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. ROYAL AGO raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, went three wide on the second turn, moved up midway down the backstretch, was put to the whip with three furlongs to run, vied three wide on the final turn and weakened. SEEKING WEST broke out and bumped with a rival, moved up after a half-mile to contest the lead, vied between rivals on the final turn and gave way. (Rail at 0 Feet)
