No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$250 to start with \$50,000 guaranteed of which \$30,000 to the owner of the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth and \$1,500 to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 117 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 1999 allowed 3 lbs.; \$15,000 in 1999 6 lbs.; \$15,000 since November 30, 9 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 1998-1999 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. BEST DRESSED TRUCK dueled for the lead from the beginning, raced outside SMILING TIME around the turn, dueled down the stretch, won driving. SMILING TIME broke in, between speed, inside turn, close throughout, outfinished for the win. POWER FLAME evenly behind the top two. MALTED raced near the back in the early going, made a mild bid. CHIEF THREE SOX saved ground in an even effort. HEZA FAST TAB never close. KENTUCKY CHARM outside speed, stopped.
