SAPPHIRES N HALOS set the pace under moderate pressure, pulled clear on the far turn and held gamely under left hand urging. GOOD HUMOR GAL was well placed on the inside, moved off the rail passing the quarter-pole, drifted out near the furlong marker then finished determinedly to just miss. DOC'S BELLE was reserved off the pace while off the rail, dropped to the rail just inside the quarter-pole, shifted back out at the top of the stretch, steadied slightly when GOOD HUMOR GAL drifted out near the furlong marker, drifted in near the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished. MARFA'S TAXES reared at the start and was off slow, settled on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. WON TON WIN went three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, raced within striking range while four wide on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch and came up empty. LADY SONYA was unhurried while saving ground, angled out at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. HASTA LA QUISTA settled just off the pace, raced three wide while between rivals on the far turn, moved to four wide entering the stretch and also came up empty. TYGER RIVER raced three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, came up empty on the far turn and faded.(Rail at 20 Feet)
