GRAY CAT was ridden along on the inside, saved ground on the turn, rallied along the rail entering the final furlong and closed strongly to win going away. DUSTY'S PLAYER broke alertly and set the pace, vied inside on the turn, battled gamely in the stretch but was outfinished late while just able to get the place. VIENTE chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, battled determinedly between rivals in the stretch and was outfinished late then missed the place. RUNNING WITH HEAT was a bit reluctant to load, chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid entering the stretch, battled determinedly on the outside but was also outfinished then missed the minor awards. ALLEY AVENUE broke inward and a bit slow, saved ground near the back of the field, moved out at the top of the stretch and reached her best stride too late. WAGER N WIN settled off the pace, moved out near the half-mile pole, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. PRECIOUS HECKLE was forced out near the half-mile pole, dropped in to race off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. BANT AMMI was fractious behind the gate, swerved out just after the start, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor.
