DOVE EXPRESS hopped at the start, chased on the outside then three wide on the turn, closed determinedly in the stretch and got up late under left hand urging. PHILLED UP dueled on the outside, was carried out a bit in upper stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong and was denied. TOGA TOO raced towards the rear of the field, lugged in a bit while off the rail the turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch, closed well on the outside and missed while up for the show. KATESEXPECTATIONS was last away, raced well back in the field, went three wide on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch and closed well but missed. GOLDATWORK dueled on the inside, drifted out a bit in upper stretch, battled gamely into deep stretch then gave way grudgingly. GOING SOUTH chased the pace between rivals, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed kick. CAPTAIN KIRK was in a bit tight after the start, saved ground towards the rear of the field and finished willingly. STREET PURPOSE came out at the start, was reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. CAPTNROBBY'S APPEAL raced well back in the field on the outside, was forced out a bit near the seven-sixteenths pole, went two then three wide on the turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. CITY LAKE was in a bit tight at the start, chased on the inside, saved ground on the turn and weakened. (Rail at 10 Feet)
