FOR ACCREDITED TEXAS-BRED, THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$375 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start with \$75,000 guaranteed of which \$45,000 to the owner of the winner, \$15,000 to second, \$8,250 to third, \$4,500 to fourth and \$2,250 to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 117 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; \$20,000 in 2010, 5 lbs.; \$15,000 since November 1, 2009, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2009-2010, as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company, will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, July 1, 2010 with 20 nominations. (S)

Footnotes

COYOTE LEGEND hit the gate at the start and had the rider lose his right iron briefly, was taken back off the pace while saving ground on the first turn, moved out midway down the backstretch, engaged the leaders while three wide on the far turn, edged clear in upper stretch and was fully extended to last under strong urging. POLTERGEIST raced three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, vied between rivals on the far turn, dropped back in upper stretch, battled back gamely in the final furlong but missed while clear for the place. UNCLE ROSE raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three then four wide on the far turn and was along for the show. MILE MARKER raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. APRIL'S PICTURE raced off the rail on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was roused while near the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. ROYAL HAY PATCH broke a bit slow, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. WASKO raced three to four wide on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, went two then three wide on the far turn and was no factor. RED HOT QUEST raced four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, came up empty while off the rail on the far turn and faded. FUDGE TRUFFLE settled on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, came up empty while saving ground on the far turn and stopped then pulled up in distress after the finish and was vanned off.
