Footnotes

PRIMAL TOUCH chased the pace, raced just off the rail on the turn, ranged up behind the leader inside the quarter-pole, rallied through a large inside opening when that rival drifted out, took over outside the furlong marker and edged clear under steady right hand urging. RED GAL'S DIAMOND showed good speed then pressed the leader, lugged out a bit while two to three wide on the turn, drifted out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, was switched to a right-handed whip, chased into the final furlong and weakened but just earned the place. SOURCE CODE was away alertly, showed good speed then chased the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick then just missed the place. RISEN IN DEED chased the pace on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn and tired. WITT'S MIDWAY was fractious behind the gate then reluctant to load, swerved in after the start, was hard ridden while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped to the inside near the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, drifted in passing the chute and lacked the needed response. TAURANGA brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along towards the back, raced off the rail on the turn, came in a bit under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip, drifted out under continued left hand urging approaching the sixteenth-pole and failed to rally. BEST DAY (MEX) raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail near the three-sixteenths pole, drifted out under left hand urging in the stretch and gained some late ground but failed to menace. RADIANT ROCK was hustled to the lead, set the pace under pressure, inched clear nearing the quarter-pole, drifted out at the top of the stretch, lost the lead to the winner shortly thereafter and gave way. SOLITARY THINKIN settled off the pace, moved a bit closer while three wide on the turn, lugged inward in upper stretch and failed to respond. PASS EM KRISTIN was ridden along on the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out outside the furlong marker and also failed to respond.

COWBOY JUSTICE brushed with a rival at the start, was ridden along towards the back, went three wide on the turn and was no factor. WILDERNESS TAVERN raced on the inside while urged along towards the rear, was shuffled back nearing the three-eighths pole and retreated.
