MAE B TODAY was well rated on the inside, inched clear on the far turn and drew off while kept to the task. WHY BILL WHY was well placed on the inside, chased on the far turn, came off the rail inside the quarter-pole and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. KIPSANDY raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, moved out near the furlong marker and just missed the place. DOT'S TWO SOCKS raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased on the far turn and tired. GUCCI BOY settled on the outside, brushed with TEXAS ROAD HOG near the half-mile pole, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn but weakened. EL D was in tight off heels entering the first turn, raced on the inside while under some restraint, saved ground through the far turn and failed to rally. COSTAMUCHO settled off the pace while off the rail, was roused on the far turn, moved out some in the stretch and also failed to rally. WHO'S STEVE prompted the pace on the outside, chased two then three wide on the far turn and gave way. SHADOW'S BABY went four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. RED SHOES went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. MICHELLES MOJO MAN moved four wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, saved ground on the far turn and was outrun.

TEXAS ROAD HOG raced inside on the first turn, moved out on the backstretch, brushed with GUCCI BOY near the half-mile pole, went three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. (Rail at 0 Feet)
