Footnotes

MISS KIPLING dueled on the inside, inched clear at the top of the stretch and held gamely under strong right hand urging. MISS KATY LAKE was void of speed, saved ground on the turn, moved out inside the furlong marker and finished fast to get the place. HAIL YES was fractious during the warm-up, moved up to race just behind the dueling leaders while off the rail, waited behind those rivals passing the quarter-pole, found room at the top of the stretch, loomed a threat into the final furlong but weakened while able to get the show. CACTUS KATE bumped with a rival at the start, angled in near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, moved around a rival near the quarter-pole, held a good striking position in upper stretch but lacked the needed response. SWEET VICTORY ROSE bumped with a rival after the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and came up empty. QUITE SHARP was away alertly, dueled on the outside then three to four wide on the turn and tired. DRINK AND A WINK broke inward at the start, was ridden along on the outside, advanced four to five wide on the turn but gave way. JANIES SONG was ridden along while off the pace, advanced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and had nothing left. READY FOR LIFE dueled between rivals, vied into the stretch and capitulated. FIDDLE PLAYER bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond. TRULY TWILIGHT bumped with a rival after the start, raced four wide on the turn, dropped to three wide entering the stretch and was no factor.
