BLUEGRASS SARA lacked early speed, was shaken up leaving the backstretch, got carried four wide by DEE'S JUSTICE early in the turn, rallied quickly passing the quarter pole, surged to the lead in upper stretch, and drew away while kept to task. ROYAL PET dueled on the outside, vied into upper stretch, proved no match for the winner, but held second while tiring. DEE'S JUSTICE raced off the pace, drifted out early on the turn, and was along for the show. TULISHA dropped well back in the field, raced four wide on the turn, and never reached contention. QUEEN TRIGGER dueled on the inside, vied into the stretch, and stopped. PRETTY DEPUTY was always outrun. CRYPTOS' BEST stumbled after the start and unseated her rider.
