FAST FASHION pressed the pace on the outside, took the lead passing the quarter-pole, battled gamely with HOLLYE LYNNE in the stretch and gamely prevailed while drifting out late. HOLLYE LYNNE was hustled from the start, chased the pace on the inside, moved out on the turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, made a bid in upper stretch, battled gamely with FAST FASHION, was carried out by that rival late and just missed. GUACAMOLE was ridden along on the outside, came four wide into the stretch, loomed a threat into the final furlong but weakened while best of the rest. U CAN BANK ON IT set the pace under pressure, lost the lead passing the quarter-pole and gave way. SHAKE A LAKE was void of speed, saved ground on the turn and showed little. PROUD JONES dropped well behind the field, saved ground on the turn and trailed throughout.
