MOUTON broke inward and bumped with a rival, settled at the rear of the field, shifted three wide and was roused passing the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch and closed strongly to win going away. SYN RIVER settled just off the pace, moved out nearing the half-mile pole, raced three wide on the turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, led into the final furlong but was overtaken while able to secure the place. FORMAL APPEAL broke out slightly at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, drew even on the turn, vied into the final furlong and weakened. TWO JAYS SECRET lunged at the start then bobbed, was well placed near the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved off the rail near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. DOUBLEARM DANCE bumped with a rival at the start, set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the turn and faded.
