Footnotes

MYSTERIOUS LIGHT set the pace under steady pressure, battled gamely with WACOS CUTIE in the stretch and proved best under strong handling. WACOS CUTIE was hustled from the start, pressed the pace on the outside, drew even nearing the quarter-pole, battled with MYSTERIOUS LIGHT in the stretch and was outfinished while well clear for the place. SINGLE FACTOR stumbled at the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty while clearly best of the rest. RED SUNSET was shut-off after the start then hustled, raced well back in the field and failed to threaten. IN THE GRAY lagged near the back of the field while near the rail and showed little. MAJIC CLOVER shifted out leaving the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came up empty on the far turn and retreated. ROSA CIELO raced three wide on the first turn, dropped to the rear on the backstretch and pulled up on the far turn but was walked off.
