Footnotes

TIMELESS DREAMER tracked the pace on the outside of HORTENSE, raced off the rail on the turn, closed determinedly in the stretch and narrowly prevailed while drifting out a bit late. HORTENSE (CHI) was well placed on the inside, saved ground on the turn, shifted out near the three-sixteenths marker, closed determinedly alongside TIMELESS DREAMER and just missed. SENECA SONG dueled on the outside, battled very gamely in the stretch and was denied. RUNS NAKED dueled on the inside, vied into the final sixteenth and weakened. BRIDAL GAL was allowed to settle into stride, raced off the rail on the turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. HADENOUGH bobbled at the start, settled on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. DESTINY'S DESIGN was reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch and showed little.(Rail at 20 Feet)
