CARE TO WIN showed good speed then chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, battled determinedly in the stretch and wore down GRANDPA N SAVANNAH in the shadow of the wire. GRANDPA N SAVANNAH was bumped at the start and forced in, moved up between rivals to take the lead, set the pace, vied inside on the turn, inched clear in upper stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong but was denied. SAND DUSTY was urged along while off the pace, moved off the rail on the turn and finished willingly for the show. MASTER TIME broke inward and hit the gate then bobbed, showed good speed then chased the pace, vied three wide on the turn and weakened. IHEARUCALLINGME was bumped at the start then forced into a rival, raced off the pace while urged along, went two then three wide on the turn and failed to respond. TEQUILERO was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. RACKET MAN chased the pace on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. PERSONAL MISSILE was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor. DELTA RUSH showed early speed then chased the pace, saved ground on the turn and faded. SIR JAIME broke awkwardly and was off slow, saved ground near the back and never reached contention. COWBOY AND A HALF veered in at the start and bumped with a rival, raced three wide on the turn and showed little.
