Footnotes

JETHRO settled while off the rail, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to win going away. SOUTHERN CAUSEWAY raced off the rail on the first turn, moved up to track the leader, chased that rival on the far turn, made a bid near the quarter-pole, led into the final furlong but was outfinished while just able to get the place. PHANTOM ROAD raced two to three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, rallied inside near the furlong marker but lacked the needed kick late while up for the show. RANGE MAN raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and gave way. DOUGH DOUGH DOUGH raced off the rail on the first turn, lingered towards the rear, raced two to three wide on the far turn and finished fast but reached his best stride too late. TEXAS ROAD HOG raced three wide on the first turn, moved up to track the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. MILAGROSO raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn

and also lacked the needed response. ROCKIN' THE STORM was reserved off the pace, raced near the rail on the turns and failed to threaten. MITSUKO'S ITRON was awkwardly into stride, raced three to four wide on both turns and was no factor. REAGAN JAMES lagged well behind the field, saved ground on both turns and was outrun. GRAND RUSTON was bumped at the start and forced in, saved ground on the first turn, dropped back while in tight midway down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn and faltered. FLIGHTLINE NINER broke inward and bumped with a rival, contested the pace on the inside, dropped back on the backstretch, was taken up near the quarter-pole and stopped. (Rail at 0 Feet)
