THE DIFFERENCE settled on the outside, advanced leaving the backstretch, vied four wide on the far turn, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under right hand urging. SECOND THOUGHTS was reserved near the back, swung six wide into the stretch and finished well but was too late. RATEEBA jostled with a rival after the start, was well placed behind the leaders, moved out late on the backstretch, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, led into the final furlong but was overtaken while able to hold the show. BYEFORNOW jostled with a rival after the start, was reserved on the outside, waited while three wide on the far turn, found room in the stretch but lacked the needed kick. ROO LETTA raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, waited while saving ground on the far turn, slipped through entering the stretch, moved out outside the furlong marker and also lacked the needed kick. DIANA'S DERBYSTORM brushed with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the inside, vied into the final furlong and weakened. DYNAMIC TEMPER lagged at the rear of the field, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced four then five wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. BAD HABIT settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and failed to rally. TIZZY ROLL contested the pace on the outside, dropped out near the quarter-pole and faded. (Rail at 0 Feet)
