Footnotes

A TOAST TO SPEED chased the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch, closed well on the outside and wore down the leader late under strong urging. HOLY HAZAAM broke inward and bumped with a rival, sped to the lead, dictated terms on the turn, led into the final furlong but was caught while clear for the place. FAST ACTING CAT broke a bit slow then was bumped, raced off the pace while urged along, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response while just able to get the show. UNIQUE CRUISE broke outward at the start, chased the pace between rivals, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. CALIROSE was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. MACKEEES LAST TRICK bobbled at the start then was bumped on both sides, raced well back in the field and failed to threaten. TRICKY TEXAN lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to menace. REYNOSA chased the pace on the outside, raced three then four wide on the turn and capitulated. (Rail at 0 Feet)
