Footnotes

MISS PEPPER was away alertly, settled while off the rail, raced near the rail on the far turn, moved out passing the furlong marker and closed well to get up late. EMMY'S PHANTASY bumped with a rival at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, led into the final furlong but was overtaken while able to get the place. YVONS GOLD raced three wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, rallied five then four wide on the far turn, had the rider lose his whip passing the three-sixteenths pole, made a bid in upper stretch but weakened and settled for the show. CROOK'S STYLE dropped to the rail late on the first turn, contested the pace on the inside, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. THIS IS MISS HEAT settled on the inside, moved out on the far turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. DIXIE KNOCKOUT bumped with a rival at the start, was bumped entering the first turn, raced five then four wide on that turn, lingered well back in the field, dropped to the rail early on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally. DARBY CAT saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, moved out on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. KRISTYS NOT SHY bumped with a rival at the start, came out and bumped DIXIE KNOCKOUT entering the first turn, went four wide on that turn, settled off the pace, was in tight near the three-eighths pole, raced three to four wide on the far turn and also came up empty. WHOSJETNOW broke out and bumped with a rival, raced three then

two wide on the first turn, contested the pace, vied outside on the far turn and tired. FATED LOVE broke outward at the start, went five then four wide on the first turn, raced up close to the pace, dropped back while four wide early on the far turn, moved in near the five-sixteenths pole and faded. CLASS RING raced two to three wide on both turns and faltered then was not urged in the stretch. STORMIN D. D. raced four then three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed while urged along, came up empty while three then four wide on the far turn and stopped.
