Footnotes

HERECOMESBERT bumped with a rival at the start, moved up on the inside, came off the rail passing the quarter-pole, made a bid entering the final furlong, inched clear into the final sixteenth and held under strong urging. STEPHENGOTHISSTAR settled off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and closed well but missed. PRACTICE TEE set the pace, vied inside on the turn, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and weakened. INDY RECORD settled just off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and came up empty. SPRING BLUES settled just off the pace, raced four then five wide on the turn and also came up empty. VALID PERFORMANCE broke inward and bumped with a rival, settled just off the pace, steadied between rivals near the three-eighths pole, steadied again passing the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to the rail near the quarter-pole and had nothing left. BEAT THE CHEAT

bumped with a rival at the start, tracked the pace, vied two to three wide on the turn and tired. SET EXPECTATIONS raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. HIGH LAKE broke awkwardly then bumped with a rival, raced off the pace, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. BLAZEN SUMMER was bumped on both sides at the start, raced four to five wide on the turn and also failed to respond. UBET' YAH was off slow, raced well back in the field, was urged along while off the rail on the turn, steadied off heels near the furlong marker and was no factor. HERE COMES BADNESS was through early and retreated on the inside. MR B SILVER SECRET raced four to five wide on the turn and was outrun.
