CLASSIC ACTRESS raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, took the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, battled gamely in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. JONES KISS jostled with a rival after the start, raced three wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside, went three then four wide on the far turn, rallied near the three-sixteenths pole, battled determinedly in the stretch and just missed. HARTFELT settled at the rear of the field, moved out on the backstretch, rallied five wide passing the quarter-pole, had the rider lose his whip near the furlong marker and missed while clear for the show. SYMPHONY OF PSALM raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, lacked room near the quarter-pole, found room in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. FUNNY TUNE was reserved on the inside, steadied while blocked from the quarter-pole into upper stretch then lacked the needed response. JACKS NEW CAT settled on the inside, was blocked from the quarter-pole to the three-sixteenths pole then came up empty. CHERRYBERRY set the clear pace, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. MACHO MON was a bit rank early while taken back, dropped towards the rear of the field, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SCARED MONEY jostled with a rival after the start, was taken back passing the wire the first time, followed the leader in second, moved closer with a half-mile to run, vied outside on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 0 Feet)
