STAKES Bob Johnson Memorial S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO \$10,500 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box with an additional \$250 to start with \$50,000 guaranteed of which \$30,000 to the owner of the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth and \$1,500 to fifth. Weights: Three Years Old, 116 lbs., Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 twice in 2008 allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 in 2008, 5 lbs.; \$18,000 in 2008, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2007-2008, as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company, will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, July 10, 2008 with 26 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile.)

**Footnotes**

ERNESTO was unhurried towards the rear, ranged up while three then four wide on the far turn, surged to the lead while drifting inward in upper stretch, kicked clear inside the furlong marker and held while racing greenly. RED ROCK CREEK saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, moved out on the far turn, rallied five wide into the stretch and closed well but was too late. OBJECTIVE settled on the inside, lacked room midway through the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. ETESAAL raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, chased four wide on the far turn and weakened. WAUPACA was rated just off the pace while near the inside, steadied while blocked on the far turn and lacked the needed response. BETA CAPO contested the pace between rivals, dropped back leaving the backstretch, chased while off the rail on the far turn and gave way. GOLD WONDER raced four wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied into the final furlong and dropped out. TRICKY CAUSEWAY contested the pace while three wide on the first turn, dropped back leaving that turn, was urged along on the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. WILLOW O WISP broke inward at the start, contested the pace on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and faded. Following a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run, no change was made to the order of finish. (Rail at 0 Feet)
