Footnotes

BELLY BUTTON DAWN broke alertly and sprinted clear, dictated terms through the turn, drew off in upper stretch and maintained a safe advantage under strong urging. CALIROSE was urged along while off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and finished well but was no threat to the winner. CLOSIN TIME CUTIE broke a bit slow, was hard ridden while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, moved in a bit near the quarter-pole, shifted out inside the furlong marker and got up for the show. HERMIGHTY was fractious in the gate, chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, drifted out inside the furlong marker and weakened then was caught for the show. YOGA GAL chased the pace through the turn and tired. ANA MARTHA was urged along towards the front of the field, lugged out a bit while three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. NAT'S STAR steadied after the start, raced towards the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. EVA IRON FIST was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor. GATHERING SKY broke outward and hit the gate, steadied while in tight early, raced three to four wide on the turn and was no factor. BETTER VISION was void of speed, raced off the rail on the turn and showed little. TOO CHIC TO PASS was hard ridden while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. FLYING PRESS broke a bit slow, raced at the back of the field, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and was outrun. (Rail at 0 Feet)
