Footnotes

MOMMA'S BADNEWS dueled on the inside, drifted out a bit in upper stretch, battled gamely with BONJURNOSE and proved best while equaling that rival's course record. BONJURNOSE dueled on the outside, battled with MOMMA'S BADNEWS in the stretch and was outfinished while clear for the place. CHANAN was in tight early then ridden along while off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and was best of the rest. GLASS MACHINE broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and improved position. LONE STAR BANDIT chased the pace, was in tight near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced three wide on the turn and weakened. WHOLELOTATRICKS chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. MT. OREAD lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. CUT THE STAR raced towards the rear of the field, went three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. (Rail at 10 Feet)
