**Footnotes**

BRENTWOOD BULLET was ridden along on the inside of a rival, raced three then four wide on the turn, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed strongly to get the lead near the furlong marker then drew clear under strong urging. JONES MAN was urged along while off the pace, raced near the rail on the turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but proved no match for the winner while well clear for the place. SEYMOUR NAEVUS moved through to take the lead, set the pace while off the rail, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and weakened while able to hold the show. RED EYE FLIGHT chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch then gave way. HAYYARD BRANCH bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. TOPOKYA was ridden along while off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and had nothing left. MAMA NOSE saved ground near the back of the field and was no factor. BLUE CRUSADER was ridden along on the outside, raced four then five wide on the turn and faded. FLYERS REWARD was urged along towards the front of the field and retreated. CAPTAIN KIRK was reluctant to load, broke outward and bumped with a rival then was taken up sharply, raced way behind the field and never reached contention. WHY YEAH was in tight after the start and showed little. TEXAS BOBCAT swerved in after the start and was outrun.
