MARQUEE EVENT moved up between rivals, chased on the turn, checked while blocked near the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker then edged clear under strong urging. KICK ON was urged along while off the pace, steadied early on the turn, squeezed through on the rail to make a bid passing the quarter-pole, vied into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while just able to get the place. SOUTHERN VINTAGE chased the pace, made a bid while four wide on the turn, vied into the final furlong and weakened then just missed the place. MERCURY EXPRESS was ridden along in the middle of the field, raced four then five wide on the turn and came up empty. WESTERN FIRE chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, steadied near the quarter-pole then moved to four wide and gave way. BUBBA KIP was hard ridden on the outside, raced four then five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and had nothing left. RED BIRD SMOKES was reluctant to load, dueled on the inside of rival while off the rail, dropped back while in tight leaving the turn and faded. RIVER RASCAL broke inward at the start, was ridden along near the inside, steadied approaching the quarter-pole, drifted out in the stretch and faltered. COMANCHE MAN drifted in after the start, dueled on the outside then three wide on the turn and stopped. ANOTHER SLEW was hard ridden while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, was carried out in the stretch and retreated. LITTLE STONEY was fractious behind the gate then broke slow, raced near the back of the field, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. EYES OF GLORY was forced in at the start, dropped to the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn and was outrun.
