Footnotes

MOODY JONES was off slow, raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, closed well to get the lead passing the furlong marker and prevailed under left hand urging. BRASS BAND settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, steadied while blocked from the three-sixteenths pole to the eighth-pole and finished fast but was too late. MOONING YOU flipped in the gate prior to the start, was in tight after the start, lingered well back in the field, raced three wide on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and closed well but missed. HIGH MEISTER was in tight near the three-quarter pole, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, vied into the final furlong and weakened. HORSE DOCTOR settled near the middle of the field, dropped back leaving the backstretch, shifted out nearing the sixteenth-pole and finished well but reached his best stride too late. CONDOR ANDINO broke very awkwardly and was off slow, lingered well back in the field, was urged along while six wide on the far turn and improved position. MARK HIS WORD settled towards the rear of the field, raced five wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. MY ANGEL was in tight nearing the first turn, settled on the inside, was roused while a bit off the rail on the far turn, swung three wide into the stretch and came up empty. FRENCH DIPLOMAT was fractious in the gate, contested the pace on the inside, vied into the final furlong and tired. BORDER TOWN was in tight on the first turn, raced in the middle of the field and dropped out. WILD BLITZ contested the pace on the outside, vied into the final furlong and gave way. (Rail at 10 Feet)
