Footnotes

SENORA TORMENTA settled off the pace, split rivals near the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch, closed fast to get the lead near the furlong marker, quickly kicked clear and proved best under strong handling. DUPLICATION raced four wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was roused on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, shifted out near the furlong marker and finished willingly while a bit green. ELEGANT STAR settled on the outside, was forced out late on the backstretch, chased four wide on the far turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong but was outfinished while able to get the show. LIKE MY DAD angled in after the start, lingered well back in the field, raced three then four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and also finished willingly. BELLE'S EXPERIENCE raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and improved position. LUCKY CRITTER set the clear pace through quick fractions, drifted out leaving the far turn, lost the lead nearing the furlong marker and tired. ZARAGOZA was taken back after the start, raced four wide on the first turn, lagged towards the rear of the field, drifted out late and failed to threaten. SUNDAY BRIDLE broke outward at the start, raced five wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and gave way. SILENT PATH lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on both turns, moved out at the top of the stretch and was no factor. ALITTLE EXTRA HEAT raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the front of the field, chased while three wide on the far turn, was in tight near the quarter-pole then bobbed, drifted five wide into the stretch and came up empty. LEGGY LADY broke outward at the start, raced four wide on the

first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, shifted in outside the three-eighths pole, came up empty while saving ground on the far turn and stopped. CRIB KICKER saved ground on the first turn, was through after a half-mile and retreated. (Rail at 10 Feet)
