Nominees to pay \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start with \$75,000 guaranteed and an additional \$25,000 from the Breeders Cup Fund For Cup nominees only. The host association guaranteed monies to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided, provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Weight: 121 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. Trophy to the winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Nominations closed Wednesday, September 22, 2004 with 33 nominations.

ENDURING WILL was reserved off the pace, rallied four wide on the far turn, took over outside the quarter-pole and drew away under a drive to prove much the best. KRISTIN'S CHARM settled off the rail, raced between rivals on the far turn, steadied inside the quarter-pole, shifted four wide into the stretch and earned the place while no match for the winner. BERDELIA was bumped at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while three wide early on the far turn, steadied near the five-sixteenths marker, continued three wide into the stretch, moved into second near the three-sixteenths marker and was caught for the place late. MALIKA'S GOLD stumbled at the start then bumped a rival, tracked the pace on the outside, chased while off the rail on the far turn and tired. KETCHMEWHEREYOUCAN broke outward and bumped a rival, set the clear pace, was collared near the five-sixteenths marker and faded. READY TO LIVE was bumped at the start, settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and came up empty. OUR LEADING LADY angled to the rail after the start, lagged behind the field, raced three wide on the second turn and failed to threaten. MISS FIFTY TWO came out at the start, raced four wide on both turns and showed little. MYRENE settled on the inside, came up empty on the far turn, broke down inside the quarter-pole and was vanned off.
